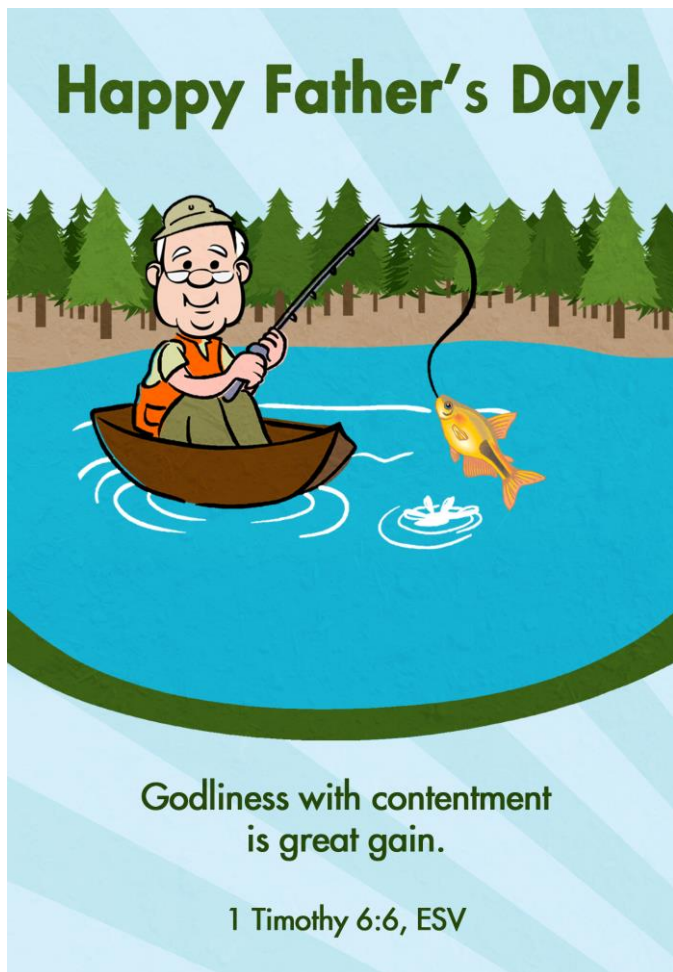

The meeting was called to order by Council President, Deb Kroon.

We did not approve Secretaries report or Treasurer's report for April, we will do that at our June meeting.

Bob's Report:

- Bob invited all youth of the parish to ride along with him in a covered wagon from Pipestone to the New Life Treatment Center on Saturday, May 19th. This is a fundraiser for the New Life Treatment Center. Anyone interested should be accompanied by at least one adult. We will meet at the Pipestone Fairgrounds at 9:30AM. We will go by covered wagon to Woodstock where a lunch will be served. Adults can drive their vehicles, or have a volunteer drive their vehicle over.

Unfinished Business:

- Deb has contact Tony Thier Construction about shingling the church. Deb was given a bid to do the job for \$10425.84. Once the shingling is done we will need some bigger gutters, this was not included in on that cost. After discussion and council consideration, Carol made a motion to go with Tony Their Construction to do the shingling and to put on bigger eve troughs. S/ Sara Henning. Motion Carried. This project may be starting in June.
- Mel followed up with the city on some parking spots in front of church. The city discussed this at their Council meeting, they will be putting up a "Church Only Parking" sign in front of church this summer.

New Business:

- Our missionary is coming home this summer and is offering to do a presentation; however, it was decided not to have her do a presentation here due to the parish needing to pay for this and not yet knowing what the cost will be. She will be splitting the cost of all her expenses when she is home between the churches that she presents at. We need a more precise cost to see if we can work it into our budget.
